Coming Home 2017 Events

CHINOOK SALMON CHALLENGE Derby runs from June 1st through July 3rd, ending at the close of the harbor office that night. The winner will be announced during the 4th of July from the grandstand. All contestants must have purchased an official derby ticket prior to the time of the catch. Derby tickets may be purchased for the entire duration of the derby (\$50), or for a 72-hour block (\$15). More than one 72-hour ticket may be purchased by an angler throughout the derby. Tickets are nonrefundable. All fish must be taken on sport tackle only. No snagging allowed. Only fresh, unfrozen king salmon may be entered into the derby. Participants may enter more than one fish during the derby. If multiple fish are entered, participant is eligible for multiple prizes if applicable. All fish entries with a derby ticket must be weighed in with the harbormaster on duty using the official scale before the close of the harbor office on the day of the catch. Fish are subject to inspection upon fillet. Anglers must accompany their catch and fill out appropriate derby paperwork upon weigh in. Contestants must fish from a vessel that departs from and returns to the Seldovia harbor. No fishing is allowed in the Seldovia Slough. Anglers must comply with Federal and Alaska Fish and Game regulations. Employees or owners of a charter company are not eligible for derby participation while on hired charter. Witnesses of derby entrant violations must submit in writing within 24 hours to the derby judge who will investigate said violation. Derby judges' rulings are final. 1st place prize will be 25% of entrant fees, 2nd place 15% of entrant fees, 3rd place 10% of entrant fees. All prize winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize winnings. Prizes may be subject to withholding based on IRS requirements. All participants will be entered in weekly prize drawings regardless if a fish is weighed in or not. Only one weekly prize may be won per participant throughout the duration of the derby. PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT June 30th – July 2rd Participants will be given photos of places and objects around town and a map to record where they found the item in the photo.
